


Definitions


- *Addictions Service*: Services are primarily for people with addictions.
- *Faith-Based*: Facility and/or programming follows the tenets of the declared religious base.
- *Government/ Other*: Facility and/or program is operated and/or funded by a government department.
- *Harm Reduction*: Facility follows operational model wherein the harmful consequences of high-risk behaviors are minimized.
- *High Level of Service*: Facilities provide close supervision of residents, assistance with medications and 24 hour staff. Meals are provided, and may include assistance with laundry and/or appointments.
- *Independent Living*: A room is provided without supervision. Residents are independently responsible for meals and medications.
- *Men's Service*: Services are designed for male residents, and/or only men are eligible for residency.
- *Mid-Level of Service*: Facilities provide some supervision of residents. Some have assistance with medications. Meals or food to make meals are provided.
- *Not-for-Profit*: The facility or organization does not seek profit or financial gain from the services provided.
- *Private Operator*: Operator is independent of government or other agencies.
- *Senior's Service*: Services are designed for senior residents, and/or only seniors are eligible for residency.
- *Service for Concurrent Disorders*: Services are designed for people with co-morbid conditions. (I.e. mental illness and addiction; mental illness and HIV infection)
- *Under \$600 per month*: Monthly costs associated with facility are less than \$600 per month for residents. Also included in this category are facilities with rent geared to income and facilities with free services.
- *Women's Service*: Services are designed for female residents, and/or only women are eligible for residency.
- *Youth Services*: Services are designed for young residents, and/or only youth are eligible for residency. Age eligibility ranges from 16-30.


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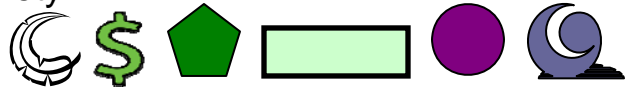
