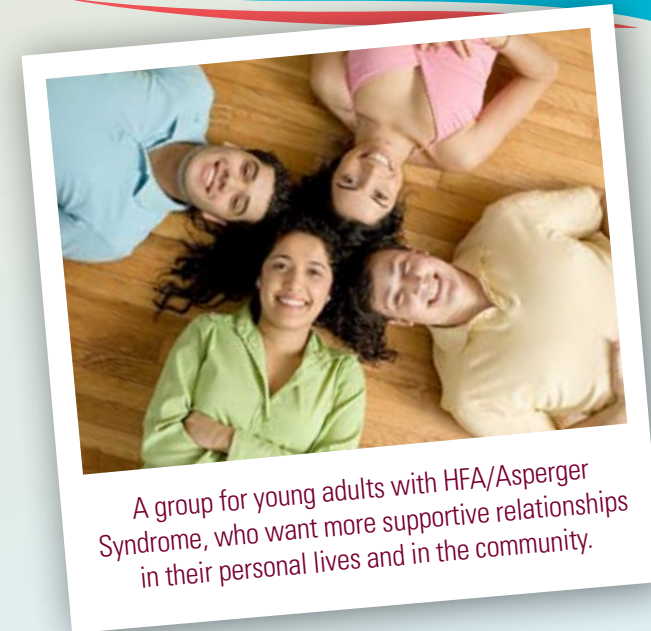

How do I register my child for the group?

- Contact ASEA and make an appointment for an interview.
- During the interview, we will talk about the group and about your child's needs and interests.
- If you decide the group is what you want, you will be asked to complete and submit an application form.
- If you are not already a member of the ASEA, you will be asked to complete and submit a membership form.
- Once your application and membership forms have been submitted and registration fees paid, a start date will be discussed with you.
- Subsidies are available for those with low incomes. Please remember to ask for a subsidy application.

Inspire

Why do people do what they do? Why don't they say what they mean? Why do some people object to the truth? And how do I figure out what people are feeling?

If these are questions you've asked yourself, this group is for you!

What is this group about?

- Groups member will work with group facilitators to explore the nature of relationship, to learn about the difference in how "Aspies" and "Neurotypicals" think and to practise relationship skills.
- Group members will have the opportunity to meet other adults with similar interests and life experiences and to share successes and as well as challenges.
- Skills will be learned through information-sharing, discussions of real-life examples, and role-playing.



Who can attend?

- You are between ages 18-24.
- You have Asperger Syndrome or HFA.
- You are interested in increasing supportive relationships in your life.
- You have the ability to contribute to and participate in group discussion.
- You have the ability to attend regularly.
- You are currently behaviorally and emotionally stable.
- You are able and willing to participate in an intake interview.

Where and When?

The group will meet two weekday evenings each month from 6:00 - 7:30 pm.

Meetings will take place at the Autism Society of Edmonton Area, #101, 11720 Kingsway Avenue.

Group meetings will be facilitated.

Is there a cost?

- Participants and their families are asked to become ASEA members: \$40 annual fee.
- An annual Program Fee of \$50 is payable to the Autism Society of Edmonton Area.
- Group members are asked to pay \$5 for each meeting they attend.
- If money is a problem, subsidies are available. Please ask for a subsidy application.
